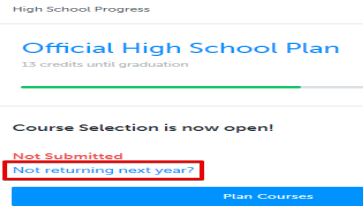

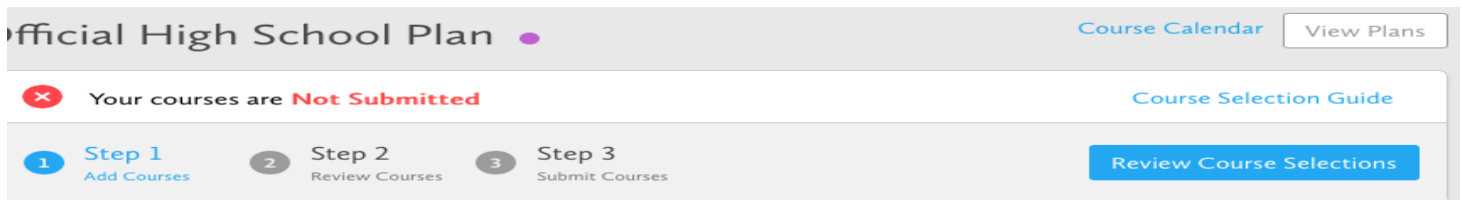
Not Returning?

Graduating and Not Returning Next Year?

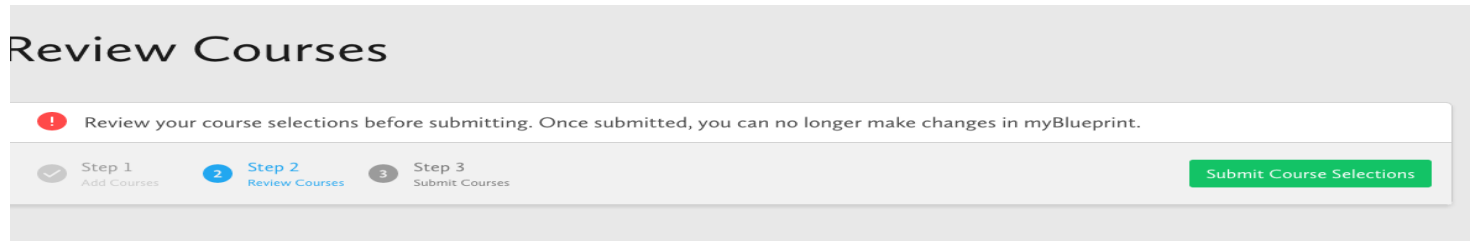
From your dashboard, click on the “Not Returning Next Year” button that appears on the High School Progress Box.
